## place value

The value of the place a digit has in a number.

Example: In 150, the place value of the digit 1 is hundreds.

A number written in a way that shows only its digits.

Example: 385

## expanded form

A number written as the sum of the values of its digits.

Example: $2,476=2,000+400+$ $70+6$

## word form

## word form

A number written in words.
Example: 125 = one hundred twenty-five

A group of 3 digits in a number, separated by commas, starting from the right.
